Flight Safety Notification General

Flight Safety Notifications (FSNs) are not mandatory in nature, but provide means such as guidance, methods, procedures and practices acceptable to the Authority for complying with regulations and other requirements in a systematic manner. These are not necessarily the only means of compliance. FSNs may also contain explanations of regulations, other guidance material, best practices or information useful to the aviation community. Unless incorporated into a regulation by reference, FSNs are not regulatory and do not create or change a regulatory requirement. A change of a regulatory requirement may come in the form of a Directive. A Flight Safety Notification is not a Directive.

COVID-19 VACCINATION

Purpose

This FSN is intended to provide guidance to airmen conducting safety sensitive aviation activity following receipt of each dose of a COVID-19 Vaccination.

Applicability

All holders of Jamaican aviation licenses and aviation medicals conducting safety sensitive aviation activities

Action

Following consultation with its Civil Aviation Medical Assessors and various International Aviation Authorities the Jamaica Civil Aviation Authority strongly recommends that operators and airmen impose a 48 hour waiting period after each dose of a COVID-19 vaccine before engaging in any safety sensitive aviation activity.

Airmen are advised to consult their Civil Aviation Medical Examiner should side effects persist beyond 48 hours following vaccination.
