Flight Safety Notification General

Flight Safety Notifications (FSNs) are not mandatory in nature, but provide means such as guidance, methods, procedures and practices acceptable to the Authority for complying with regulations and other requirements in a systematic manner. These are not necessarily the only means of compliance. FSNs may also contain explanations of regulations, other guidance material, best practices or information useful to the aviation community. Unless incorporated into a regulation by reference, FSNs are not regulatory and do not create or change a regulatory requirement. A change of a regulatory requirement may come in the form of a Directive. A Flight Safety Notification is not a Directive.

Training of Foreign Airmen

Introduction

The applicability of foreign nationals holding Jamaican licences as per the Civil Aviation Regulation Schedule 8A, Section 8.001, limits these persons to either be working commercially in Jamaica or be operating a Jamaican registered aircraft.

This has limited the ability of some Approved Training Organizations and the Jamaica Defence Force to recommend the issuance of a licence for these foreign nationals.

Applicability

This FSN is applicable to all foreign airmen being trained at an Approved Training Organization and the Jamaica Defence Force.

Effectivity

This FSN is effective immediately and will remain in force until the necessary regulatory changes have been made.

Action

All foreign airmen being trained at an Approved Training Organization and the Jamaica Defence Force, shall be applicable for a Jamaican airman licence as long as they follow the same training

syllabus, licencing requirements and application process as Jamaican nationals in a similar training course.

In addition to the standard application process, the foreign airman will request the necessary relief utilizing the sample letter attached in Appendix 1.
